St. James Parish School District has partnered with Teche Action Clinic to provide a School-Based Health Center (SBHC) on the campus of St. James High School. This health facility is designed to meet the primary health care, behavioral health care, and urgent care needs of students enrolled in St. James Parish schools. To receive services at the SBHC, parents/guardians must complete the Consent Form to enroll their students as registered members. The SBHC staff will gather health history information about your child and will also provide information about Immunizations that can be given. You may consent for your child to receive routine immunizations. Your child can get medical and counseling services at the school-based health center. The center is staffed by health professionals including medical providers, nurses, and behavioral health specialists. All students are welcome and once the consent form is on file, students can use the School-Based Health Center as often as they need. School-based health centers allow students to get the healthcare and mental health support they need to prepare for their next adventures, whether that's a big test, sports team tryouts, college, or a job.
